All Saints Ilkley are delighted to announce the appointment of Carry Lynott as Heritage Manager.

Carry's role will cover all aspects of the exciting heritage plan in progress at All Saints Ilkley, which will tell, and interpret, the story of the church and its people from the times of the Roman Fort, through the life of the medieval and Victorian eras, right up to the current 21<sup>st</sup>.
